- 2. Applicant must meet the following minimum requirements:
  - (a) Providing documentation in similar project references with the following criteria:
    - (i) At least three (3) relevant re-waterproofing and maintenance works projects for heritage buildings with contract sum approx. HK\$3.5M in the last 5 years;
    - (ii) At least three (3) relevant re-waterproofing works project references in the last 5 years; and
    - (iii) At least three (3) relevant timber joinery repairs project references in the last 5 years.
  - (b) Listed under the Register of General Building Contractors ("RGBC") in BD's registered contractors list and "specialist contractor" in the Development Bureau's "List of Approved Suppliers of Materials and Specialist Contractors for Public Works" in the "Repair and Restoration of Historic Buildings" category;

Note: Otherwise, the RGBC should separately engage a "specialist contractor" as mentioned above as its domestic sub-contractor;

- (c) Strong in-house workforce in Hong Kong; and
- (d) Strong technical and financial position.
