



Notice for Inviting Expression of Interest

1. The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts hereby invites company to express interest for the below project:

Replacement Works of Wood Deck at the Bethanie Campus
(Tender Ref. APA-PT3716)

2. Applicant must meet the following minimum requirements:

- (a) Satisfactorily completed similar projects with the following criteria:
 - (i) At least three (3) relevant renovation or improvement works projects for heritage buildings with contract sum approx. HK\$2M in the last 5 years;
 - (ii) At least one (1) relevant installation works of wood deck project in the last 5 years; and
 - (iii) At least three (3) relevant waterproofing works project in the last 5 years.
- (b) On the contractor lists in (i) Building Department's registered contractor list under the Registration of General Building Contractors ("RGBC") and (ii) Specialist Contractors in the Development Bureau's "List of Approved Suppliers of Materials and Specialist Contractors for Public Works" in the "Repair and Restoration of Historic Buildings" category;
Note: Otherwise, the RGBC should separately engage a "specialist contractor" as mentioned above as its domestic sub-contractor;
- (c) Strong in-house workforce in Hong Kong; and
- (d) Strong technical and financial position.

Applicants must fill in the Prequalification of Tenderer Form & Checklist with supporting documents, Application Form for Inclusion in the Registered Suppliers List (if you are new vendor) and submit to the Academy by depositing into the tender box at the entrance of Administration Block of the Academy at 1 Gloucester Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong on or before 11:00 a.m., 16 April 2025.
